Proposal to partially amend PAAM Constitution (as per update of 04 March 2021):

Clause 4 MEMBERSHIP

- 4.1 Ordinary Membership shall be open to all Malaysians above the age of 18 who have attended any course, in-plant training or any other programmes on AOTS/HIDA Scholarships or Programmes conducted by AOTS/HIDA and PAAM.

Proposed to amend as follows:

- i) To remove "HIDA" and replaced with "Japan"

Proposed Clause:

Clause 4 MEMBERSHIP

- 4.1 Ordinary Membership shall be open to all Malaysians above the age of 18 who have attended any course, in-plant training or any other programmes on AOTS **Japan** Scholarships or programmes conducted by AOTS **Japan** and PAAM.

Clause 21 INTERPRETATION

The logo used by PAAM constitution is the same logo used since day one of PAAM's inception. It bears the logo of the Association for Overseas Technical Scholarships (AOTS), a Japanese Government agency which is tasked to provide training and development to human resources of third world economies, of which Malaysia is one of its recipients.

Proposed to amend as follows:

- i) To keep the abbreviation "AOTS" without the brackets, and to leave out "the Association for Overseas Technical Scholarships"
- ii) To replace the comma "," at the end of "of third world economies" with a full-stop "."
- iii) To leave out the words "of which" and change the words "one of its recipients" and begin a new sentence as "Malaysia is also a recipient."

Proposed clause:

Clause 21 INTERPRETATION

The logo used by PAAM constitution is the same logo used since day one of PAAM's inception. It bears the logo of AOTS, a Japanese Government agency which is tasked to provide training and development to human resources of third world economies. Malaysia is also a recipient.

Clause 23 FLAG, SYMBOL AND BADGE

- iii) To leave out the words "of which" and also change the phrase "one of its recipients" to 'also a recipient' and begin a new sentence as "Malaysia is also a recipient."

Clause 23 FLAG, SYMBOL AND BADGE
